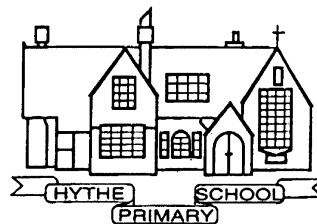

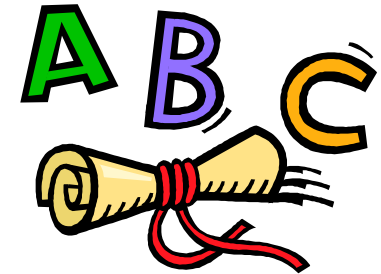
We will:
