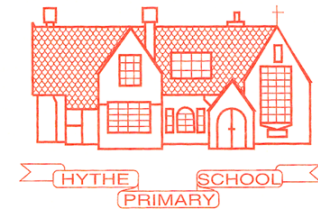


Romans



English

This term the children in Year 3/4 are looking at An Alien In The Jam factory as the stimulus. This will include a focus on inference in reading, and cohesion within and between paragraphs in their writing. They will be creating characters and writing a sequel to the story.



Maths

We will begin by finishing work on fractions and decimals. Afterwards, children will be learning about time and money, with units on shape and position to follow.



French

Children will be learning about colours, animals and sizes, then using them to verbally rehearse sentences.



Geography

Children will be learning about what causes earthquakes and volcanoes and what areas of our planet are prone to them. Finally, they will look at what can be done to mitigate against the dangers of these natural occurrences.

Science

Children will be learning about plants and how they produce their food. Following that, they will be focusing on light and reflection.



History

This term we are studying the Romans and how this fascinating and influential era paved the way for so much of our culture today. We will look at their amazing innovations and ability to design and engineer. We will look at their daily life and how clothes and food were sourced as well as what their houses were like.



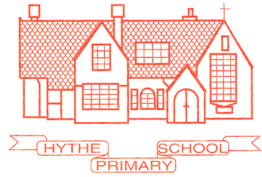
Computing

Our topic is called 'Presenting' and will use Google Slides and Purple Mash to create a presentation .



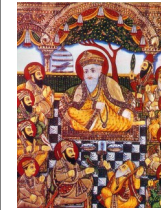
Music

Romans

Religious education



Children are continuing to learn about Islam, exploring the five pillars, the concept of Umma and what it means to be a Muslim today. This will be linked to British values. We will also have a visit from teachers from the Islam community.

Art

Children will be researching the Roman art of mosaic and designing and making their own.



P.E.

Athletics will be the focus in Games this term as we prepare for sports day. Children will be practising a variety of activities including sprinting, sustaining a longer run, jumping and skipping. Children will also be working on improving their reaction and response through throwing and catching drills and games.

Multiplication check

Children in Year 4 will be taking the multiplication tables check between the dates of the 1st and 12th June. This is statutory for all pupils and is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently up to 12, through a set of 25 timed questions.

Homework

- Children will continue to be provided with a homework booklet for the term. This will have space to record their weekly reading and Times Table Rockstars alongside a short spelling task.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be focussing on the core value Health and Wellbeing. We will be learning about the importance of oral hygiene. In RSE we will be learning about how our bodies change as we get older. There will be a parent meeting about subject content in Summer 2. The date will follow later this term.
