<b>OUTER WEAR</b>	Coat (with hood is recommended) - Clearly labelled
<b>WINTER WEAR</b>	Skirt, trousers or pinafore in plain grey/black White (school) polo shirt White shirt (long or short-sleeved) School/plain red sweatshirt/fleece/cardigan White/grey/black socks or black/grey tights Flat black shoes (not boots or trainers)
<b>SUMMER WEAR</b>	Grey/black trousers or shorts Red gingham dress Pinafore dress in plain grey/black White (school) polo shirt White shirt (long or short-sleeved) School sweatshirt/cardigan/fleece White/grey/black socks or black/grey tights Black shoes (not boots, trainers or sandals) Sunhat (recommended)
<b>NB – TRAINERS SHOULD NOT BE WORN FOR ANYTHING OTHER THAN PE</b>	
<b>PE KIT (to be worn to school on PE days)</b>	
<b>SUMMER</b>	<b>Plain/unbranded</b> black/grey/white shorts, cycle shorts or gym skirts, house colour t-shirt, trainers and socks
<b>WINTER</b>	<b>Plain/unbranded</b> black/grey/white shorts, house colour t-shirt, trainers and socks <b>Plain/unbranded</b> dark-coloured tracksuit bottoms – navy/black/grey – and <b>plain/unbranded</b> black sweatshirts or tracksuit tops may be worn in cold weather.
<b>HAIR and ACCESSORIES</b>	
<b>JEWELLERY</b>	Single stud earring(s) – THESE MUST BE REMOVED FOR PE (OR COVERED IF NEWLY PIERCED) Watch – THIS MUST BE REMOVED FOR PE
<b>HAIR and ACCESSORIES</b>	Simple and easy for children to maintain. Large hair accessories, dyed hair and/or tramlines are not appropriate for school. Hair accessories should be small, plain and practical. Hair extensions are not allowed. False nails, painted nails or false eyelashes are not allowed.

Please note that younger children should wear easy fasten shoes and clothes whenever possible (no ankle boots or sandals) and **micropore tape must be provided by parents for children wearing earrings in P.E lessons (unless they can be removed).**
