Maths

This half term the children in year 1 will be consolidating what they know about number and place value and exploring geometry, money and time.

Year 2 will be focussing on statistics and how mathematicians present data, solving problems involving all 4 operations (+ - x ÷) and exploring position and direction and associated vocabulary. Please look through the advice in your Reading Rocket for how to help your child with maths. Year 2 remember you have your 3 times table practise packs sent out this year.

Music - The children will be exploring untuned instruments and composing their own piece of music.



English-

This half term the children will be writing a fact file about their chosen rainforest animal. They will also be writing then 'performing' a poster about saving the rainforests.



R.E: This half term the children will be thinking about change and how it can affect us. They will be thinking about how Christians believe that Jesus changes some people's lives and what effect this had on them.

Geography- This half term the children will learn how to identify the locations of jungles in equatorial and tropical rainforests. They will also learn their features and different climates and typical wildlife linked to rainforests.



Helping your child with English

Please continue to read regularly with your child for just 10 minutes a day, discussing the plot and the characters and interesting new words. They also need to practise writing at home as often as possible. Please encourage them to concentrate on their punctuation and spellings.

Science- This half term the children will be continuing to learn about how plants germinate and make new plants. They will also be applying their sorting and classifying skills to scientific questions.

Physical Education -

Games- This half term the children will be learning various athletic skills in readiness for our sports day.

Gym - This half term the children will be practising their floor work skills and playing bat & ball games.

P.S.H.E. The children will be learning about the differences between the male and female body. They will be naming the different body parts.

They will also be thinking about the next academic year and moving on to their new classes.
